## Message from the Principal

Dear Raider Nation,

February is a very busy and important month as we begin guiding our students toward their choices for the next academic year. Our dedicated counselors are working diligently and thoughtfully to ensure they provide both students and families with all the necessary information to make well-informed decisions. We are committed to supporting our students as they navigate this important time and make choices that will help shape their academic journey.

I wanted to share some important information about communication regarding grades and assignments that you may have already noticed. In an effort to improve our communication about students' grades during each 9-week period, I have programmed Skyward to send a report to each family on Saturday mornings, which will make you aware of any failing grades or missing assignments. You still have the ability to log in to Family Access at any time during the week, and you can always set up your account to alert you of missing or failing grades each day of the week, if you would like. Your child's teachers should be communicating to you, as well, if there are missing grades, exams that need to be re-taken or made up, or if your child is at risk of failing for the 9 weeks. We never want the report card at the end of a 9-week period to be a surprise, so increasing our communication with you, and encouraging

student responsibility to communicate will help everyone be informed and on the same page!

Thank you for your continued partnership as we work together to help our students thrive.

Chris Herren, a basketball legend from Fall River, Massachusetts, was an All-American, broke scoring records and was recruited by the nation's top colleges. Herren realized his lifelong dream of playing in the NBA when he was drafted by the Denver Nuggets in 1999 and then traded to his hometown team, the Boston Celtics, before losing his career and almost his family to the disease of addiction.

In long term recovery since 2008, Chris inspires people to start the conversation on wellness and educate themselves on the disease of addiction. It is his hope that strength will be found in the struggle and communities will come TOGETHER to address the issue of substance use disorder, advocate for effective treatment and embrace the power of recovery.

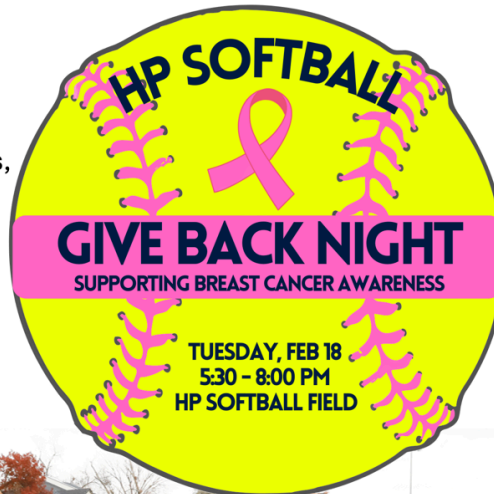
